#### FREE BREAKFAST, SNACKS AND LUNCHES.

There will be free hot lunches again in the canteen from Monday 4th September for all pupils. Please ensure your child wears comfortable, sensible shoes and we advise against the wearing of jewellery with the exception of stud earrings and a watch for safety reasons. # ALADDIN

Please ensure that your Aladdin Connect app is working properly after the Summer break. Sometimes it may require you having to enter your log in details again. If you do not have it, we strongly urge you to download the app and our HSCL Darryl and Orla, school secretary, Lucy or your child's class teacher can assist you if you are having difficulties. # Sports.
