Bí Cinealta - Procedures to Prevent and Address Bullying Behaviour in Schools.

Thank you to all our parents and guardians for completing the survey to inform our new Anti-bullying policy which is currently under review and will be implemented in September 2025. There will also be a student-friendly version of the policy available.

Bí Cineálta are the Irish words for Be Kind.

We want everyone at our school to feel safe and happy.

Bullying Behaviour is defined as the targeted behaviour, online or offline that causes harm. The harm caused can be physical, social and/or emotional in nature. Bullying

behaviour is repeated over time and involves an imbalance of power in relationships between two people or groups of people in society.

Bullying behaviour is all 3 of the elements below:

- 1. targeted
- 2. repeated
- 3. with intent to cause harm (physical/emotional/social)


