We strongly urge families to have submitted their application form along with a copy of your child's birth cert by Christmas.





### Bí Cineálta Student Policy



We want everyone at our school to feel safe and happy. If you think that you or someone else is being bullied, you need to tell a teacher or another adult that you trust.

They will know what to do to help.



If a student tells a staff member that they think they are being bullied, we will:

- talk with the student
- ask the student what they want to happen
- · work out a plan together
- · talk to their parents
- talk to the other student(s)
- talk to the other student's parents

Holy Family Senior School has a
Bí Cineálta policy to try to stop bullying
behaviour. We look at this policy every year to
see what is working well or what we could do
better. We will always consult with our students
when reviewing the policy.
